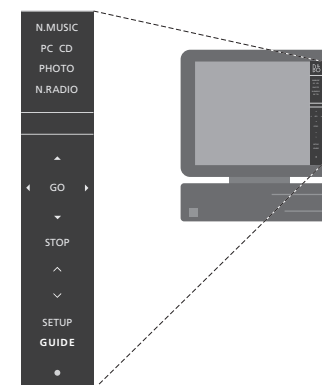

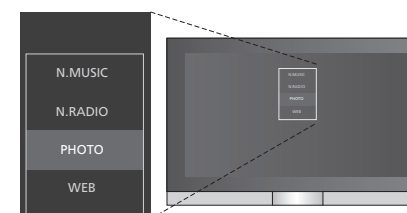

How to use your remote control

This describes how you use the basic functions on the BeoMaster with Beo5 and Beo4.

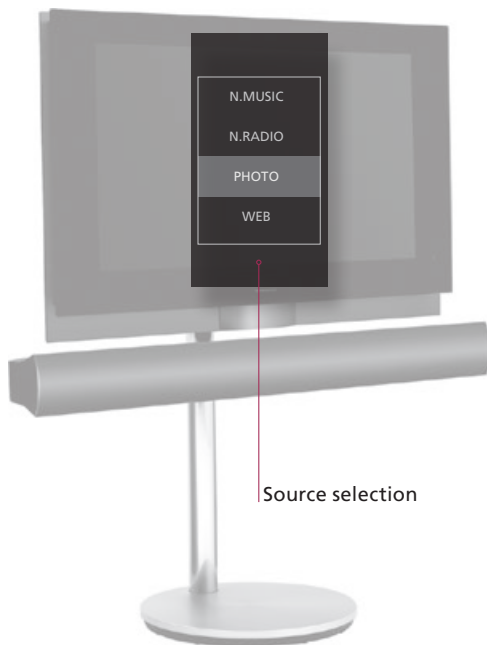

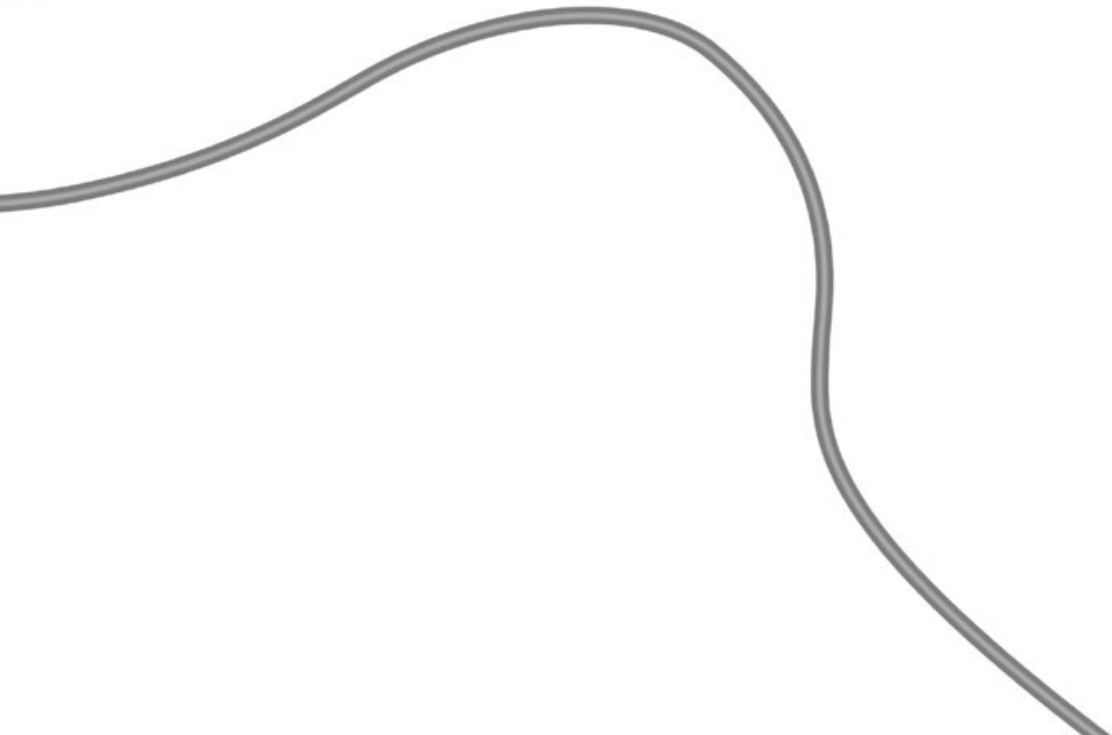
- *1 **Activate a source** You can use the number buttons 1–4 to select a source.
- *2 **Skip groups/lists** Press left/right on your remote control to skip groups/lists.
- *3 **Remove content from list or group** You can remove contents from lists and coloured lists. In all other views the function deletes the content. The function also deletes lists.

NOTE! When you switch on the BeoMaster, the start up time may be up to 30 seconds.

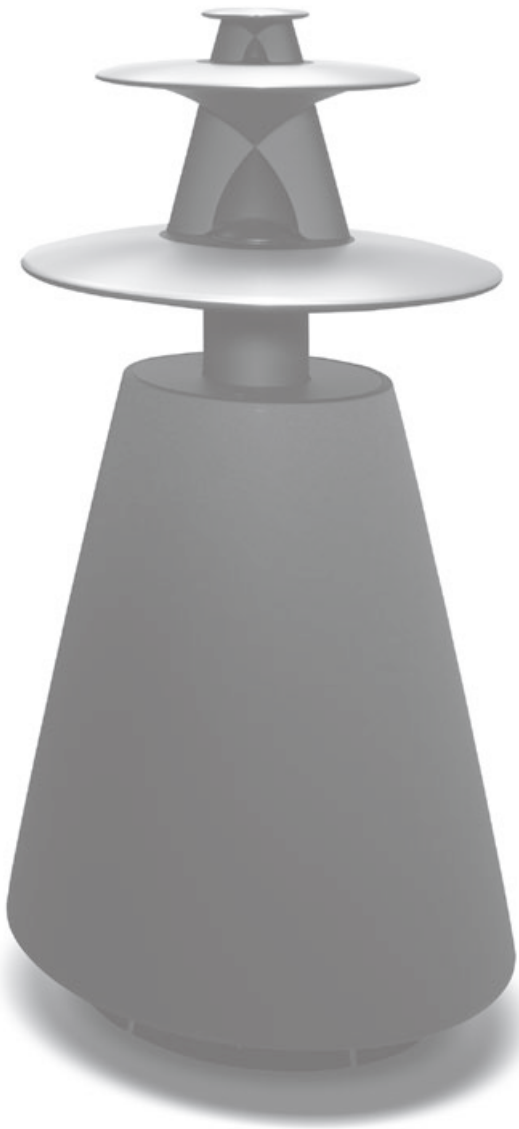

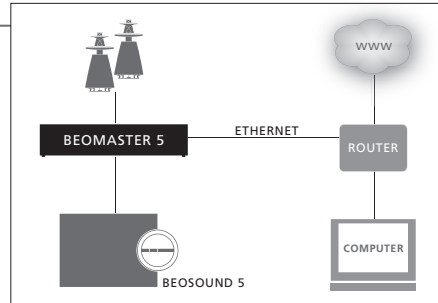


Set up your system

BeoSound 5 setup

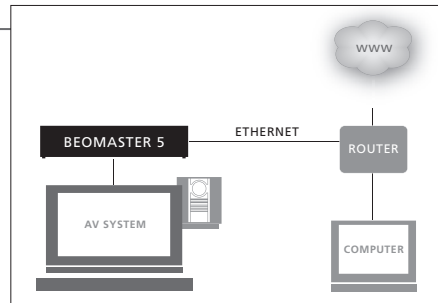
When the BeoMaster is set up with BeoSound 5, operation of Music and Radio takes place via BeoSound 5.

The BeoMaster is set up with your audio/video system in your home.

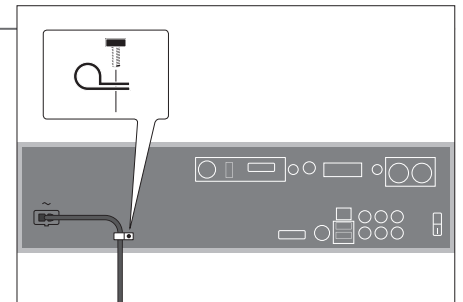
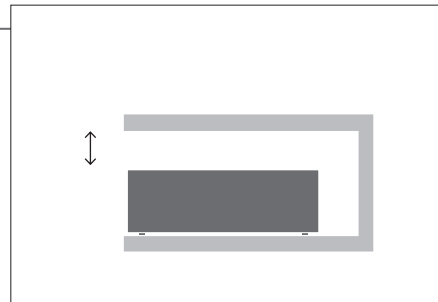

Important

To ensure proper ventilation, allow at least 5 cm (2") of space at the sides of the product and 10 cm (4") above it.

For safety reasons, the mains cord from the wall outlet *must be* secured to the product. Use the enclosed cable clamp and screw.

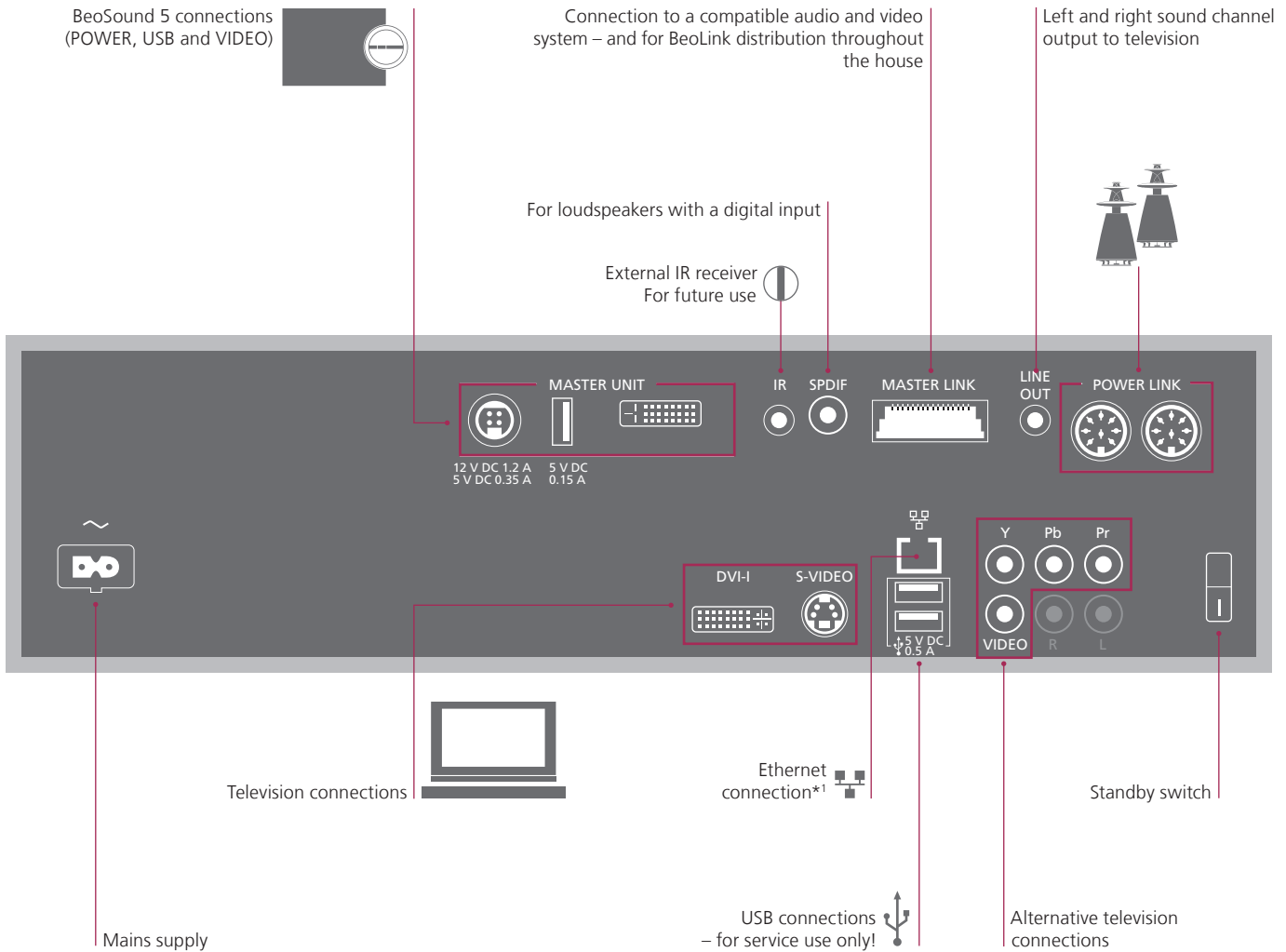


Information

Cleaning Wipe dust off the surfaces using a dry, soft cloth. To remove stains or dirt, use a soft, damp cloth and a solution of water and mild detergent, such as washing-up liquid.

The BeoMaster can only be switched off completely by disconnecting it from the wall socket.

Do not connect any of the products in your system to the mains supply, until you have made all the connections.



Loudspeakers The Power Link connections are used in BeoSound 5 setups only. In audio/video setups the loudspeakers are connected to the audio or video system.

Waste Electrical and Electronic Equipment (WEEE) – Environmental protection
